Significant, sustained service to FLC organization

**Representative of the Year -
Significant contribution to FLC within past year.**

**Outstanding Service Award -
Sustained support to FLC from a non-lab employee.**

STEM Award- Recognizes efforts by an FLC Lab employee or team that has demonstrated outstanding work in support of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Education during the past year.

Award Criteria

Exceptional support for STEM education within the last 5 years.

STEM education encompasses K-12 through college, University and post-doc.

Must utilize existing TT mechanisms and/or create novel approach to conducting educational outreach

Award is for a body of work – single or multiple efforts and achievements may be included.

State and Local Government Award – Recognizes successful partnerships between State and local Governments and the Federal Laboratories for Regional Economic Benefit.

Award Criteria

Nominees must include FLC Lab employees, employees of State and Local government directly involved.

Nomination must provide a clear explanation of the partnership, innovative approach to addressing needs, and a demonstrated result.

Nomination must include background on how initiative operates and why it was created.

Specific roles, goals, objectives of each nominee

Describe innovation or creativity of each nominee

What has been impact to date, how is impact determined.

Laboratory Director of the Year Award

The National Advisory Council of the FLC honors Laboratory Directors who have made maximum contributions to the overall enhancement of technology transfer for economic development.

Accomplishments related to the transfer of technology from the federal laboratory to industry—including support of FLC activities, internal accomplishments, industry involvement, and community service—are the primary criteria for the award.

Rookie of the Year

Award Criteria

Demonstrated Exceptional service performing their TT responsibilities within their organization over the past year.

Award is for a body of work – single or multiple efforts encompassing more than one Tech Transfer agreement/achievement.

Nominee must be new to Tech Transfer – with five or less years experience.

One Rookie of the year award per year.

Outstanding Technology Transfer Professional Award

Award Criteria

Significant contributions to the transfer of Federally Developed Technology

Demonstration of innovation and/or creativity in transferring specific technology/product/service.

Transfer occurred within last five years.

Interagency Partnership Award

Award Criteria

Describe nominee's accomplishments – why they deserve award

Only FLC Agency or Lab Reps may submit. Maximum of one submission

Nominees must be employees of FLC member Labs

Excellence in Technology Transfer Award

Award Criteria

Revised for 2011. Must use current format.

Agency definitions for Tech Transfer have been addressed

Point values have changed

Submission Checklist is now in first section – must include.

Time Frame for the transfer has been added –

Nominee must be FLC employee

Exemplary individual service to the FLC over a sustained period of time.

Never received the award before.

FLC Service Awards (cont.)

Representative of the Year - Significant contribution to FLC within past year.

Award Criteria

FLC Rep or alternate

Significant contribution made in prior year

Demonstrated outstanding Regional leadership, or participated in appropriate activities

Participated in activities for outreach to a new FLC User group

Participated in TT activities applicable to other member Labs

FLC Service Awards (cont.)

Outstanding Service Award - Sustained support to FLC from a non-lab employee.

Award Criteria

Nominee must be an FLC Rep or alternative.

Participated in TT activities applicable to other Labs

Participate in activities for outreach to a new FLC user group

Demonstrated outstanding regional leadership or participated in appropriate activities

Significant contribution made in year preceding nomination

Nominee not received the award within three years.

Nomination Deadline

Nominations in all categories (except Laboratory Director of the Year Award) must be electronically submitted by 8:00 p.m. EDT (5:00 p.m. PDT) on Thursday, October 14, 2010 to Michele Chambers at the FLC Management Support Office at mchambers@utrs.com.

No nominations will be accepted after this time. You will receive a confirmation e-mail upon receipt of your nomination.
