Inventor Discloses Software
Invention Disclosure form

Head of Technology Transfer makes
the subject software publicly available

Potential Licensee contacts
the Head of Technology Transfer

Head of Technology Transfer determines if the
licensee intends to use the software for a
government or a non-government use

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If for private commercial use, Head of Technology Transfer sends
“Commercial Use Software License Request Form”

Potential Licensee returns the
“Commercial Use Software License Request Form”
to Head of Technology Transfer.

Head of Technology Transfer reviews the completed
form with the PPPL Researcher, the PPPL Researcher’s
supervisor, and the Office of Technology Licensing at Princeton University

Head of Technology Transfer contacts the Program Manager
to obtain written permission to commercially license the software.

Head of Technology Transfer contacts the PPPL
Export Control Officer and provides the information required
on the nature of the software and on the Potential Licensee
for an Export Control Review.

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Commercial Use Software License Request Form,
Program Manager Approval, Export Control approval are forwarded
to the Princeton University Office of Technology Licensing

The Princeton University Office of Technology Licensing enters
into negotiations with the Potential Licensee

If mutually agreeable licensing terms are reached, and PPPL Researcher(s)
Find them acceptable, the Princeton University Office of Technology Licensing
requests the right to assert copyright in the software and to license the
software to U. S. Dept Of Energy

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A copyright notice is affixed in accordance with the rules of 17 U.S.C. 401 on the copyrighted software and acknowledgment of government sponsorship.

The Princeton University Office of Technology Licensing sends the license agreement to the licensee for signature

One set of software and documentation is forwarded to the Licensee through the Princeton University Office to Technology Licensing.

The other set of software and documentation is forwarded to the DOE Energy Science and Technology Software Center
